We've changed our name! We are now the **Academic** Collaborative for Integrative Health (ACIH).

After discussing a name change for almost a year, we realized that a new name would better define who we are. Many in our disciplines believe that that it is time to no longer use the terms 'alternative' or 'complementary' to describe our fields and what we do, and instead, include words such as 'collaborative, integrative and health'.

We believe our new name reflects the essence of our disciplines - a focus on health and well-being, as well as the treatment of diseases and conditions. And in many ways we are a collaborative, as we represent councils of colleges, accreditation commissions and certification/testing agencies, as well as emerging disciplines and traditional world medicines and individual colleges.
